When and How to Check In for Your Southwest Flight

Southwest Online Check-In Options

Recommended Airport Arrival Times

This allows time for check-in, baggage drop, security screening, and reaching your gate. Missing the check-in deadline may result in losing your seat.

Understanding Southwest Boarding Groups

Southwest uses a zone-based boarding system to organize the process efficiently. Passengers board in numbered zones displayed on their boarding pass.  +1/844/565/1867 First Class, Southwest One, and Diamond Medallion members board first. Other elite status holders, premium cabin passengers, and families with young children board next.

Main Cabin passengers board in assigned zones. Listen for your zone announcement at the gate.

Sky Priority Boarding Benefits

Sky Priority boarding is available to First Class, Southwest One, Southwest Premium Select, and Southwest Comfort+ passengers. Elite Rapid Rewards Medallion members also receive this benefit regardless of their cabin.  +1/844/565/1867 Sky Priority passengers use dedicated lanes at check-in, security (where available), and boarding. This expedited service reduces wait times throughout the airport experience.

What to Bring for Check-In and Boarding

Always carry a valid government-issued photo ID for domestic flights. International travelers must present a passport and any required visas or travel documents.  +1/844/565/1867 Have your boarding pass ready, either printed or on your mobile device. Ensure your boarding pass name matches your identification exactly. Document verification is crucial for smooth check-in.
